Epistle: St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 2:10-16 Gospel: Matthew 4:18-23

2nd Sunday of Matthew, The Gospel of Matthew 4:18-23: At that time, as Jesus walked by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen.
