Minutes of the Monthly Meeting - January 17, 2017 St. John Chrysostom Albanian Orthodox Church

Secretary's Report: The December 2016 minutes was presented by Michele Lorimer. Nilda Salavachi made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bill Bortner seconded the motion, all were in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Nilda Salavachi presented the December 2016 Treasurer's Report. 1) Unfortunately our goal for pledges (\$60,000.00) was not achieved. We received 113 pledges totaling \$55,816.00. Last year we received 116 pledges totaling \$69,560.00. Last year we received pledges from two parishioners who were donors totaling \$17,500.00. They did not pledge this year, thus the large difference. 2) Although the income and expense statement show a \$33,000.00 deficit, \$18,880.00 was for the south side roof repair. Money was transferred from the investment account to cover this expense. The church floor project totaled just under \$20,000.00. We had received \$25,000.00 from St. John the Baptist in 2015 which covered this expense. 3) Under the expense line items that were over budget were substitute priest, candles and liturgical supplies (which was paid for with the donation made by Stephanie and Victor Sarkissian), building maintenance and miscellaneous expenses. 4) Investment account \$258,204.42. Michele Lorimer made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. Sergio Georgi seconded the motion, all were in favor.
