Forgiveness Sunday: At the close of this day, in preparation for the Great Fast/Lent, a Vespers service is normally held. At the end of this service, the people seek forgiveness from the Christ by receiving His blessing through the hand of the priest. Since God forgives our sins according to the degree that we forgive others (Lord's Prayer) it is also appropriate at this time and throughout the year to privately seek forgiveness from those whom we may have offended. As we are not able to have a Vesper service this year, it is appropriate (after Divine Liturgy) to quietly approach anyone with whom we had fallen out of fraternal love (aphiladelphia) and ask forgiveness of that person, that the Great Lent might start well on "Clean Monday".
